## **Issues Discussed:**

- Vamshi Mugatha requested that a date be fixed for the AGM much in advance, so that we can get better attendance.
- Nadeem spoke about changing the season's format. He suggested we play two separate and parallel leagues – One in the 40 over format and another in the 20 over format. The 40 over league be played on Saturday and 20 over league be played on Sunday. The intention was to get more players to join CCL as well as to give fringe players in the club a chance to participate. A committee will be formed to define the details and will be sent to the LMC for approval.
- EC will look into getting sponsorships and cleaning up the list of current sponsors.
- Raymond spoke about changing the Central West championship format from knockout to league. CCL would visit Texas and play one of the leagues twice. The other two leagues would visit Colorado and play CCL twice when the visit. This will provide more exposure to our players.
- Jarrar clarified the selection of the Central West Representative. The League President is CCL's representative. Others (like Jarrar) are picked by the Regional Director to the Board of Directors.
- CCL will continue to be a member of USACA. Ballots should be received shortly by the Club Presidents.
- Gopal raised the issue of slow overrate and the inconsistency in penalizing the teams. CACU will come up with a new set of rules which will go to the LMC for approval and if approved, implemented next year.
- CCL SC will be selected by the EC and the SC will select the Cougars probables for next year by Dec / Jan. There are two documents that define the Cougars setup and the SC. These need to be put in the CCL Documents folder.
- Kervyn talked about have a picnic / potluck during the season to bring the members together.
