In such cases, the issues in question presented for voting at a General Meeting can be deferred to the League Management Committee for investigation and subsequent approval or rejection. The decision to defer the issue to the League Management Committee shall be decided by a vote at a General Meeting.

5.2 Awards

5.2.1 Best Batting - League

This award shall be given to the person that has completed 50% or more of the total number of games in the league fixtures, AND scored more than 300 runs in the league fixtures. EC shall decide the winner, based on total runs scored, average, strike rate, and any other factors that EC considers relevant to the decision. In case there is noone who has scored more than 300 runs, the award shall be given to the person scoring the most runs. In the event of a tie, EC shall decide to whom the award shall be given.

5.2.2 Best Bowling - League

This award shall be given to the person who has completed 50% or more of the total number of games in the league fixtures, AND taken 20 or more wickets in the League fixtures during the season. EC shall decide on the winner, based on wickets taken, strike rate, economy rate and any other factors that EC considers relevant to the decision. If no bowler has taken 20 or more wickets, the award shall be given to the bowler with the most wickets. In the event of a tie, EC shall decide to whom the award is given.

5.2.3 Best Allrounder

This award shall be given to the person who has completed 50% or more of the total number of games in the league fixtures, AND scored 200 or more runs, AND taken 15 or more wickets. EC shall decide on the winner, based on the bowling statistics, batting statistics, number of catches taken, and any other factors that EC considers relevant to the decision. If there is noone who fits the criteria above, EC shall decide on the winner.

This award shall be given to the person who has completed 50% or more of the total number of knockout games played by the associated team, AND plays in the knockout final.
